

**BUILDING MAINTENANCE
ELECTRICIAN**

Ector County Building Maintenance Department is in need of an electrician. The electrician will be under the general supervision of the Building Maintenance Director and the Maintenance Foreman.

PRIMARY DUTIES: The electrician will perform electrical work in relation to the repair and maintenance of county property. Will train maintenance technicians in all phases of electrical work, purchases electrical supplies and insures distribution, inspects all work in progress or completed work to insure that workmanship confirms to specification requirements. Must have a very high knowledge of voltage, amperage, wattage, wiring of electrical systems, repairing and maintaining heating and air conditioning; must have knowledge of city electrical codes; be able to communicate with vendors, the public and government officials and be able to learn and carry out general policies.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: HS/GED; must have a Master's electrician's license and a valid Texas Driver's License with an insurable driving record. Interviews will be scheduled depending on certification.

SALARY: \$16.11 p/h plus excellent benefits; hours are 8:00 am - 5:00 pm; 40 hours per week; Monday thru Friday. Will have occasional weekend hours and will be on On-Call duty.
