

MECHANIC II EQUIPMENT SERVICES

The Ector County Equipment Services Department is in need of a Mechanic II. The Mechanic II will be under the supervision of the Foreman and the Equipment Services Director.

PRIMARY DUTIES: The Mechanic II will be responsible for performing diagnosis and complete repairs on all systems related to heavy trucks (over 1 ton) and construction equipment to include, but not limited to, preventative maintenance, over hauls, equipment rig up, field service and all other duties as assigned by the foreman and/or the Director.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Must have a valid Texas Commercial driver's license with an insurable driving record. High School diploma or GED preferred. Must meet physical requirements of job and have five (5) years experience in preventative maintenance practices and performing diagnosis and complete repairs, major and minor on all systems related to heavy trucks (over 1 ton) and construction equipment with gas and diesel engines. Qualified applicant must have own basic tools and have a working knowledge of desk top computer operation.

SALARY: Depending on experience, salary is negotiable and we offer excellent benefits; 40 hours per week, Monday thru Friday, 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m..
