The Ector County Sheriff's Office is in need of a Deputy I. The Deputy I will be under the supervision of the Sergeant.

PRIMARY DUTIES: The Deputy I will perform duties of peace officer in regards to keeping the peace, protection of lives and property through presence, observation, investigation, identification and apprehension of violators of federal, state, and local laws where jurisdiction applies.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: High school diploma/GED; must have a valid Texas driver's license with an insurable driving record; must be a Certified Peace Officer through TCLEOSE certification to carry a handgun; prefer 3 years experience on patrol; must be 21 years of age or older and must have effective interpersonal skills and vision correctable to 20/20.

SALARY: \$15.94 p/h plus excellent benefits or salary negotiable based on experience; (Shift work 7a.m. - 7p.m. & 7p.m. - 7a.m.; Sunday thru Saturday).
