ASST. DISTRICT ATTORNEY-SEXUAL ASSAULT

The District Attorney's Office is in need of an Attorney. The Attorney will be under the supervision of the District Attorney and will primarily handle sexual assault as well as injury to children cases.

PRIMARY DUTIES: The Attorney will review felony sexual assault and injury to a child cases, and will be responsible for handling these cases from indictment through final disposition, including pleas or trials. The attorney will also be responsible for working with and guiding outside agencies involved in child abuse cases. The attorney will prosecute these cases in all four of Ector County's District Courts and will assist the District Attorney in other felony cases as needed.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Juris Doctorate, and State Bar of Texas license to practice law. Prefer three (3) to five (5) years courtroom experience as prosecutor or in private practice with heavy criminal trial experience. Must have a valid Texas driver's license with an insurable driving record.

SALARY: Depending on experience. Usual working hours are Monday thru Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.; however, additional hours may sometimes be required.
