EQUIPMENT OPERATOR II
PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT – SOLID WASTE REMEDIATION

The Public Works Department is seeking an Equipment Operator for solid waste and litter remediation in Ector County. The Equipment Operator will be under the direct supervision of the Public Works Director, but refers all unusual issues pertaining to illegal dumping to the Director of Environmental Enforcement.

PRIMARY DUTIES: The operator will be responsible for driving and operating a hi-rail grapple and roll-off truck to load & haul solid waste materials and litter from illegal dumping in the County; operates other heavy equipment on public roadways in accordance with prevailing traffic laws and regulations, and according to the County and departmental safety policies; performs inventory and inspections of solid waste illegal dumping to be moved to confirm quantities and conditions and report all unusual conditions to the Director of Environmental Enforcement; Secures cargo for transport, and unload materials at the landfill center (or as determined by the Public Works Director or the Environmental Enforcement Director); and performs tasks as described and related to solid waste collection in the job description, and any other job-related duty as assigned by the immediate supervisor.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: High School/GED graduate preferred, **plus** must have a Class A or B Commercial Driver's License with endorsements and insurable driving record; must have a minimum of one (1) year of experience and/or job training in bulk solid waste collection and disposal, including at least one (1) year of experience driving and operating heavy equipment for road or alley maintenance; **or**, any combination of education and experience that has been achieved and provide the required knowledge, skills, and abilities sufficient to successfully perform the duties and responsibilities of this job; and must have thorough knowledge of methods, materials, procedures, and equipment used in the collection of light to bulk solid waste materials and in the maintenance and repair of local roads and alleys.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: The position requires the use of approved safety-toe boot shoes; safety vest, safety glasses, and hard hat during work. Will be required to work outside normal hours, to include weekends and holidays, in emergencies and inclement weather.

SALARY & WORK HOURS: \$ 23.13 - \$ 26.01 per hour, depending qualification and experience; 40 hours per week; seasonal hours are 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: OCTOBER 29, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. **Please note that no specific date is assigned as to when this position may be filled. It could be filled earlier than the deadline.**
