PUBLIC HEARING AND RELATED DISCUSSION AND POTENTIAL ACTION

1. PUBLIC HEARING – Pursuant to Chapter 232 of the Texas Local Government Code and other authority, a public hearing will be conducted by the Commissioners Court regarding the proposed Subdivision and Manufactured Home Rental Community Regulations for Ector County, Texas (“Regulations”). 
EXECUTIVE SESSION


