**THE COUNTY COURTS AT LAW  
OF ECTOR COUNTY, TEXAS  
DRESSCODE**

**AT ALL FUTURE DOCKET CALLS, HEARINGS, AND TRIAL DATES, THE FOLLOWING DRESS CODE SHALL BE OBSERVED:**

**THE ECTOR COUNTY COURTS AT LAW WILL OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING DRESS CODE, WHICH APPLIES TO ALL PERSONS WHO ARE REQUIRED TO ENTER THE COURTROOM, FOR ANY AND ALL CIVIL AND CRIMINAL MATTERS:**

**MEN ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR: LONG PANTS, A COLLARED SHIRT (must be tucked in), SHOES AND SOCKS. (The use of a tie and /or suit jacket are optional).**

**WOMEN ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR: SHOES (flip flops are not permitted) AND ANY OF THE FOLLOWING: A DRESS, PANTS OR A SKIRT WITH A BLOUSE OR CASUAL DRESS SHIRT.**

**THE FOLLOWING TYPES OF CLOTHING ARE NOT PERMITTED, AND IF WORN WILL BE GROUNDS FOR REFUSING ADMITTANCE TO, OR REMOVAL FROM, THE COURTROOM:**

**Hats (applies to both men and women)**

**Flip flops (applies to both men and women)**

**Halter tops/tube tops**

**T-shirts/muscle shirts**

**See-Through tops**

**Shorts**

**Ripped jeans**

**Baggy pants that fall below your waist and expose underwear**

**Clothing that exposes midriff**

**Pajamas/sweat pants**

**Clothing that depicts or promotes violence, sex acts, drug use, illegal or inappropriate activity or profanity**

**REMOVAL FROM THE COURTROOM, OR BEING REFUSED ADMITTANCE, MAY RESULT IN A WARRANT BEING ISSUED FOR FAILURE TO APPEAR AT YOUR HEARING (in a criminal matter) OR A DEFAULT JUDGMENT BEING ENTERED AGAINST YOU (in a civil matter).**

**ALL DECISIONS ON THE APPROPRIATENESS OF ATTIRE WILL BE MADE BY COURT PERSONNEL.**
